



## Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Young Research Fellowship 2020-21

In reverential memory of late President and great Scientist Dr. A.P.J Abdul Kalam, TERRE Policy Centre, instituted the scheme for Dr. A.P.J Abdul Kalam Young Research Fellowship with the aim of distinguishing young Researchers from India with extraordinary promise and creativity who have made notable research contributions in the field of Environment protection. However, this fellowship has been solely managed and funded by TERRE. Dr. Abdul kalam had high expectations from the youth of India and keeping this in context, TERRE has announced noble award on the occasion of Late Dr. Kalam's birth anniversary - 15 October 2020.

TERRE Policy Centre wanted to boost creativity & innovative mind of young generation of India, through this fellowship program. Age criteria for this fellowship were 18 to 25 Indian resident and nature of fellowship is INR 25,000/- to winner & consolation prize was INR 10,000/- with E-Certificate. After the fellowship announcement more than 1200 candidates submitted their project ideas on given topics through online registration & submission system. Topic for fellowship was plastic, clean air, Agriculture, Smart Environment-friendly technology & innovation. Participants submitted very innovative & eco-friendly projects so it is very difficult to segregate among the total entries. After reading & studying all received projects TERRE team shortlisted 15 applications which have innovative ideas which will be helpful for environment.

Our juries conducted a video interview with 15 fellowship applicants on 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> of May 2021. Each day juries interviewed 8 applicants in which they shared and explain their project idea. After their presentation juries asked questions related to their projects and guided them to improvise their project efficiency and help them to make their projects more practical. Mr. Ashok Mangotra (Former secretary to Government of India, and former president Dr. Abdul Kalam) and Dr. Vinita Apte (Founder director of TERRE policy centre) were the juries for final interviews, Mr. Anil Arora(Head of GEF-UNDP small grante programme for more than 20 years) & Dr. Satish Kulkarni(First recipients of the Jagdish bose national science talemt search in Culcatta & awarded by Jawaharlal Nehru).






